Filming the Final RPP Presentation

You need to film your presentation where half of the screen is your camera and the other half is the presentation.

Click <u>here</u> to watch the video to learn about specific filming requirements and which software you can use to film your RPP Presentation.

You are not required to use the video recording tools mentioned in the video above, but the video you film must have clear (not lagging) video and follow the ½ presentation ½ webcam rule.

Exceptions will only be made for students who do not have access to a webcam at all as stated in the video.

Submitting the Final RPP Presentation

The submission deadline for your Final Research Project Proposal Presentation is 11pm on Thursday, November 26, 2020.

To submit your final RPP Presentation, you need to upload the final video to your **OWE Homework folder** before the deadline.

Rename the final presentation using the following filename conventions:



I am originally from Moscow. I attended university in the United States, where I received a Bachelor's degree in Geography and Business and a Master's in Education. I have lived in the United States, Russia, Trinidad and Tobago, Saudi Arabia, and now Kazakhstan. I began my teaching career at the Moscow State Institute of International Relations (MGIMO University), where I taught English for Academic Purposes at the School of Political Science. This was followed by working for close to five years at the Moscow branch of NVIDIA, designing and implementing educational programs for engineers which were aimed at enhancing their English language proficiency. In Saudi Arabia I taught English to female college students as education in Saudi Arabia is gender segregated.

I arrived in Kazakhstan in the summer of 2019. I look forward to exploring more of Kazakhstan, but this has been hindered by the pandemic. Due to the friendly nature of Kazakhstani people and fluency in Russian, I feel very comfortable in this country. I fact, I am giving Russian lessons to the CPS community. Like most people, I love traveling. The top countries on my to-visit list are Chile (I am fascinated by astronomy and can't wait to visit the Atacama Desert and its multiple observatories), Uzbekistan, and Mongolia.
